

Pacific Crest Ride General Information

NOTICE: We have yet to get all our GPS'ing done. Our trails sustained high winds and rain this year. The trails we use do not allow for an ATV, as the trees are close together. We must scout them on horseback and then return on foot to clear them with chainsaws. We just finished this week. So far, over 30 trees blocked the trails. We will be GPS'ing while we ribbon and may have the loops up on Ride With GPS before you ride out, if not you will have to follow the ribbons and carry your map and trail guide. Please be patient, we are cantering as fast as we can!

There will be no host to greet you, please come up to the Ride Table to let us know you are here and pick up a Ride Packet if you haven't already downloaded and printed one before you came.

Friday, June 17, 25 Milers:

Vets there Friday morning. Your ride meeting is at 10 am, Noon start. You have till 6 pm to finish. All Vet checks in camp for you

Saturday, June 18, TR/ 35/ 55/ 75 Riders

Do not vet in until noon on Friday after the 25 milers are out. Your ride meeting will be at 7:30 pm on Friday evening. For Crews, the First Vet check and only OUT check for the 35/ 55/ 75 is at Peterson Sno Park in the morning. It is about 5 miles east on Dead Indian Memorial Rd. You can't miss it. We provide a truck for you to through your Vet bag in provided it isn't packed for a winter in Montana, lol!

We will be providing a meal on Saturday afternoon, so feel free to get dinner during or after you finish, this goes for you 75 milers!

Awards are Sunday morning, like 8ish! We want the 75's to be able to attend!

There will be 2 porta-potties in camp (except during Saturday, when we will take one to the Vet Check at Peterson Sno Park, DO NOT BE IN THE PORTA POTTIE WHEN WE PULL AWAY or you may be in for a wild ride! Also, 2 built in potties near the Vet check in camp.

Please return any manure wagons that are provided by JCParks back to the manure area. Please clean up your camp before you head for home.

Please keep your dogs on a leash. No camp fires.

If you are not riding or would just like to help, we'd love to meet you, please introduce yourself over at the Management table.
