35 mile trail description

Ribbons are RED, WHITE & BLUE

Ribbons are on the right. Three ribbons mark an upcoming turn, look to find the ribbon telling you which way to turn. Ribbons are on your RIGHT shoulder

This route is one loop. I am talking about it in two sections: <u>Upper</u> from camp to the vet check and Lower from vet check to ride camp

UPPER LOOP:

Leave Lily Glen through the gate across DIM Hwy. Look both ways and be careful. The ride will START ACROSS THE STREET so there is no need to hurry.

In about a mile, take a Right turn onto dirt road. Follow until the dirt road ends at a gravel road. Turn right. Follow for a short ways. Swerve left around the cattleguard. Just past the cattleguard turn Right and go through the yellow gate. Follow to the end of the road, turn Left onto trail. Trail will end at a gravel road, Turn Right. Follow to red cinder road (150) on the Right. Go to the marked Right turn into the woods. Follow the trail to cross the gravel road, jog Right, then Left up another trail. Follow the ribbons till the trail ends in a sharp Right turn onto a cinder road next to an irrigation ditch. There is a marked water stop nearby if you need it.

Follow the ditch road to the gravel road, bear Left. look for a sharp Left off the road. the trail leads down to a creek crossing and up the other side to another ditch road. This is road crosses the paved 37 road - BE CAUTIOUS in xing.

Follow the ditch road, at the fork go left downhill to cross another creek. Follow the ditch road for another mile+ to a marked crossing leading Right down and across the ditch to a dirt road. Follow the dirt road/trail to its end on a gravel road. Turn Left. Follow gravel road for about a 1/2 mile to a Left turn into the woods. Follow through the woods, crossing two creeks till you end at a gravel road. Turn Right. Follow the gravel road to where the pavement starts. Go easy on the pavement for about 100 feet to the next Right turn onto a gravel road. Follow for about a mile to the end and continue into the dirt and meadow. When the meadow trail ends at the paved road, cross and continue on the dirt road. Follow about a mile and look for the Left turn into the woods to the PCT. Turn Right (South) onto the PCT. You are bout a mile from the vet check. The PCT crosses a paved highway into the vet check. This is a good place to walk. There will be water in the parking area before the timer's station.

LOWER LOOP

Leave Vet Check on the PCT. In about 1.5 mile look for the Right turn OFF the PCT. Follow the trail to the end of a dirt road, turn Left and follow out to the end. Turn Right. Follow to merge Right on a gravel road, then sharp Left onto another gravel road. Follow this for about a mile. Look for Right turn onto another trail. Follow down to Dirt road, turn Right. Water is below the road. The path down and up is ribboned. Follow dirt road to a Left turn into the woods. Follow trail to a Right, then Left turn onto a dirt road. Follow to the end on a dirt road. TURN RIGHT up a rocky section of road to a LEFT uphill. Follow the uphill road to the end on another dirt road. Turn Left. Go a short distance to a Right Turn. Follow dirt road AROUND a cattleguard. Shortly after the cattleguard turn Left. Follow to another Right turn, then a well marked LEFT turn. Follow that road to an open cleared area. Turn Left over the rise and down to a dirt road, turn Right. Follow to the cable gate and go around. Turn Left for a short distance, Turn Right to cross the paved road and get onto the dirt road across the street. Follow to the end, follow the trail, cross a creek and keep coming to turn Left onto the Lake Trail. Follow the Lake Trail back to a green gate into ride camp. Follow the trail and cross the creek back into ride camp.
